As a member you can expect the following:


- To rub shoulders with fellow genealogists and exchange knowledge and information. The members of the branch are a diverse group of people who all have a healthy interest in genealogy, which they practise as a hobby in one form or another.
- Relevant news is shared on the branch's Telegram group, advice is given and questions that come our way are brainstormed.
- Ten monthly meetings are organised annually during which authoritative speakers give talks on interesting topics. This is done in contact sessions if possible but the talks are also shared via Zoom in real time. Recordings are then available on our website.
- Ten issues of the branch's newsletter, The Genealogist, are sent out annually. Articles are contributed by our members. Furthermore, the GGSA quarterly magazine, Familia, is also sent to members. Members can also make contributions and the content focuses more on formal contributions to genealogical knowledge. Support is also given to members who want to publish their research independently.

- Members participate in projects according to their preference and capacity. This includes, for example, the transcription of the Voters' Roll (Rhino Project), collection of funeral letters, the compilation of ancestral charts, cemetery excursions to photograph gravestones and focus groups for specific computer applications, genetic (DNA) genealogy, etc.
- Archive tours are arranged annually, with discount for members. During the tour members are guided in research and the use of the archive based on their existing expertise.
- The NTvI branch's comprehensive collection of genealogical research sources is housed in the library of the Heritage Foundation at the Voortrekker Monument. It is available to all members of the GGSA. Members can also use the Identitynumber.org website.
