

THOMAS EASTLAND VERONA BLAKE

While researching information for the EVA family the names of Eastland, Graham and Hatton appear. Some one mentioned Elizabeth Eastland married to J.C. Hatton and having one son William Hatton. There is some confusion here. Elizabeth Goldfinch Eastland was born in Dover, Kew and baptised 30.10.1846 in Deal. She came with her parents in Menze's Party on the Weymouth at age 4. She married first to William Graham secondly to J.C. Hatton (John Christopher). A Death Notice for William Graham gives his place of birth as City of Edinburgh, son of Stewart and Jane Graham. By trade a blacksmith. The Death Notice listing property and names of 3 children, William, Robert and Jane was signed by Elizabeth C Graham and two witnesses; George Eastland and Thomas Eastland. The death notice for Elizabeth Hadden lists only one child William Graham. Robert and Jane had predeceased her. This William Graham married Mary Elizabeth Eva and had 5 children. After her death he married Hannah Pike and had a further 7 children.

Elizabeth Goldfinch Eastland (Graham) x Joseph Christopher Haddon and had several children of which two daughters Elizabeth Ellen Walkett Hatten and Victoria Alice Owen Hatton married Eva Brothers.

William Grahams Death Notice lists his parents as William Graham and Elizabeth Goldfinch born Eastland. His wife as Mary Elizabeth Eva died 16.7.1874. 2nd Hannah Pike who signed the Death Notice. The Death Notice for Elizabeth Hatton is confusing having the only child's name as William Graham and not William Graham Hatten.

The Death Notice for Elizabeth Hatton is confusing having the only child's name as William Graham and not William Graham Hatten.
